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## CHRIST OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS

#### A Fundamental, All-Embracing Truth

In Part II the subject of Righteousness by Faith has been dealt with largely in its historical aspect,—the time, the place, and the manner in which the Lord chose to bring His people face to face with this vital, fundamental truth of the gospel for the purpose of adding strength, power, and expansion to the proclamation of the third angel's message which had been so signally intrusted to them. We now come to an analysis of the subject in its broad aspects, as it is presented in the writings of the Spirit of Prophecy.

The Minneapolis Conference adjourned with the minds of the delegates in more or less uncertainty and confusion regarding the message of Righteousness by Faith that had been set forth. But the presentation of this vital truth, with all the agitation, discussion, and perplexity it occasioned, was not in vain by any means. It started new thought and study regarding the great theme of justification by faith, and led many into a better, richer appreciation of the Saviour as their substitute and surety. Among the greatest of all the blessings that have followed that meeting has been the abundant instruction which the Lord has sent to His people through the Spirit of Prophecy regarding our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ and how to live His life by faith. This instruction is truly illuminating.

It is worthy of note that since the Minneapolis Conference there have come to us, through the Spirit of Prophecy, the following volumes of instruction:

"Steps to Christ," in 1892.

"Thoughts From the Mount of Blessing," in 1896

"The Desire of Ages," in 1898

"Christ's Object Lessons," in 1900.

"The Ministry of Healing," in 1905.

"The Acts of the Apostles," in 1911.

It is well known to all who have read these books that the great dominant theme is Christ,—His victorious life in humanity, His atoning sacrifice on the cross, and how He now may be made unto us poor mortals, wisdom, righteousness, sanctification, and redemption.

Besides these intensely spiritual books, scores and scores of messages have been sent to us through the Review and Herald, which contain the clearest and most helpful instruction regarding the subject of righteousness by faith. All this is of priceless value to the church. It throws a flood of light upon the great problem of redemption in all its phases.

In studying further into the subject of righteousness by faith, as set forth in the Spirit of Prophecy, it is important that there should be a clear understanding of its

scope. This is not a doctrine of limited intent or of minor consequence. It is not a subject with which one may or may not be familiar and fare as well. Righteousness by Faith, in its larger meaning, embraces every vital, fundamental truth of the gospel. It begins with man's moral standing when created, and deals with—

- 9. Sinless life of Christ.
- 10. Vicarious death of the Son of God.
- 11. Burial, resurrection, and ascension.
- 12. The Father's assurance of a satisfactory substitution.
- 13. The coming of the Holy Spirit.
- 14. Ministry of Jesus in the heavenly sanctuary
- 15. The part required of the sinner in order to be redeemed.
- 16. Nature of faith, repentance, confession, obedience.
- 17. Meaning and experience of regeneration, justification, and sanctification.
- 18. Need and place of the Holy Spirit and Word of God in making real to men what was made possible on the cross.
- 19. Victory over sin through the indwelling Christ.
- 20. Place of works in the life of the believer.
- 21. Place of prayer in receiving and holding the righteousness of Christ.

22. The culmination and deliverance in the return of the Redeemer.

This is the great sweep of truth embraced in the short phrase "righteousness by faith." "A small key," says Pierson, "may open a very complex lock and a very large door, and that door itself may lead into a vast building with priceless stores of wealth and beauty." The brief phrase, "righteousness by faith," opens the door to all the priceless stores of the wealth and glory of the gospel in Christ Jesus our Lord.

It is worth while to note at this point some of the expressions found in the writings of the Spirit of Prophecy which serve to introduce or provide appropriate framework for this beautiful truth.

#### It Bears the Divine Credentials

"The present message, justification by faith, is a message from God; it bears the divine credentials, for its fruit is unto holiness." --Review and Herald, Sept. 3, 1889.

#### A Precious Thought

"The thought that the righteousness of Christ is imputed to us, not because of any merit on our part, but as a free gift from God, seemed a precious thought." -- Review and Herald, Sept. 3, 1889.

#### It Is Sweetest Melodies

"The sweetest melodies that come from human lips-justification by faith, and the

righteousness of Christ." -- Review and Herald, April 4, 1895.

#### It Is a Pure White Pearl

"The righteousness of Christ, as a pure white pearl, has no defect, no stain, no guilt. This righteousness may be ours." --Review and Herald, Aug. 8, 1899.

In its truest sense, righteousness by faith is not a theory; it is an experience, a vital change which takes place in the believer in Christ. It gives the sinner a new standing before God. It is the essence of Christianity, for we read:

"The sum and substance of the whole matter of Christian grace and experience is contained in believing on Christ, in knowing God and His Son whom He hath sent." "Religion means the abiding of Christ in the heart, and where He is, the soul goes on in spiritual activity, ever growing in grace, ever going on to perfection." --Review and Herald, May 21, 1892.

To lose sight of this wonderful, fundamental, all-embracing truth is to miss that which is vital in the plan of redemption.

# THE SPIRIT THAT ORIGINATED EVIL AND ITS MANIFESTATION TODAY

Our text is found in Isaiah, chapter 2, verse 22 -- "Cease ye from man, whose breath is in his nostrils: for wherein is he to be accounted of?"

In this verse of Scripture God recommends that we cease from man. And the reason given is that man's breath is in his nostrils; because without breath he is but a lump of dirt, and therefore of no account.

The plea would not have been made if the people were not putting their trust in man rather than in God for their salvation; that is, rather than doing what the noble Bereans did, studying to know whether "these things be so," God's people are giving heed to what others think or say. They are today doing what hundreds of thousands were doing in Jesus' day; trusting in the opinions of their learned priests, scribes, and rabbis. The Jews' giving heed to hearsay instead of engaging in personal investigation and experience of their own with the source of truth is, therefore, the thing that crucified the Lord.

And where do you suppose such confidence in man originated? We often think that evil originated with Eve when she reached for the forbidden fruit. But the fact is that evil already existed before Eve came in contact with it. Let us read this from the prophet Isaiah:

"How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! how art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations! For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north: I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the Most High. Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit." --Isa. 14:12-15.

We understand that Satan's name before he sinned was Lucifer, and that he sinned before Eve sinned, that he was impersonated in the serpent that deceived Eve. We shall therefore consider the sin in heaven before we further consider sin on earth.

Satan, we are told, was not the only sinner in heaven, for with him were cast out of Heaven a third of the angelic host (Rev. 12:4). These were cast out of Heaven because they gave heed to the words of Lucifer, to a man in Heaven, rather than giving heed to the word of God. This was the angels' downfall. Lucifer himself fell when he aspired to be as God.

These two sins--trust in man, and desire to exalt self--are still the leading sin elements now here on earth. This was Eve's stumbling block and to many even today it is still the stumbling block. No, appetite alone was not the cause of Eve's downfall. The serpent did not say, "Thou shouldst eat of this fruit for it is wonderful, more delicious than any other fruit in the garden of God." But he said: "God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil." Gen. 3:5.

The fruit, of course, appealed to her, but she was tempted by the idea of having the opportunity to be exalted to the throne of God, to be exalted to the same position to which Lucifer himself aspired. Lucifer must have honestly believed that he would be as God if the angels in Heaven and the men on earth would but take orders from him.

And so we see that the Devil deceived Eve on the same grounds he deceived himself and his angels, the only difference being that he caused Eve to eat of the fruit which he himself and his angels would not eat. Consequently, Eve sinned against her physical being, too, by taking into it something that was not created for food, and consequently she died. But Satan and his angels still live.

This same stumbling block, the desire to exalt self, has predominated throughout the ages, and it predominates today. No, I am not making rash and empty statements. I have the facts to back up my words. For example, in the days of the Exodus

Movement, there were Korah, Dathan, and Abiram who aspired to the office of Moses and Aaron as Lucifer aspired to the throne of God, the highest offices they could have longed for. And did not Lucifer fall because of wanting to be above all others for nothing more than to exalt self? And was not the same true of the fall of Korah, Dathan and Abiram?

Today we see the same clamoring for position even in our own churches. The offices of Church Elders, Sabbath School Superintendents, Secretaries, Pianists, and other such church offices, let us remember, hold no monetary compensation. But in spite of it, every year in most of the churches, as far as I have been able to observe, there is a clamor and a quarrel by men and women for one or more of these Since there is no monetary offices. remuneration for such services, then what is the fuss about if not purely for self-exaltation, if not for the purpose of being looked up to as somebody?

You see then, that the same clamor for self-promotion that existed with Lucifer, with Eve, with others down through the ages, exists today. My statement, you see, is backed up by actual facts. Moreover, if such be the case with those who receive no monetary consideration for their services, then what could be the case with those who are well paid? This question you can answer for yourself to your own satisfaction.

Plainly, one who aspires to position simply for self-exaltation, especially when such an office holds out spiritual responsibilities as does a church office, such a one should not be given any consideration whatsoever. And if he already has any station of responsibility, he should be relieved of it, for such high-minded leaders are spiritually blind, and they draw the multitude to themselves as did Lucifer draw the angels to himself and to doom.

Moreover, this class of leaders, dead to Christ and alive to themselves, as a rule love to parade, and even to exaggerate their religious deeds. Such should therefore be branded as Satan inspired disciple seekers. This class of men are naturally clever. They manage to gain the confidence of the people by the same method with which the priests and rabbis in Jesus' time deceived the nation: They prayed where they could be seen; they marred their faces to appear to be fasting; and they made it their business to air far and wide whatever good they did; they were adept at making themselves appear very religious, pious, philanthropic, and righteous.

Multitudes are still charmed by such so-called good men, and multitudes unquestionably accept their decisions as if they were God's decisions. Against such, remember Inspiration warms: "Cease ye from man, whose breath is in his nostrils: for wherein is he to be accounted of?" Isa. 2:22.

That these man worshipers be seen even more realistically, let me tell you something: Thousands have advised us to recant if the president of the General

Conference sees no light in our teaching, if he sees no light in our revival and reformation among God's people. They seem to be just as sincere in this as were the Jews who confidently took sides against Jesus by making the high priest's decisions their own decisions!

Their wish for us to recant "if the president sees no light," shows that they are copying the Jews of old, rather than looking into the matter themselves, with confidence in the Spirit of God to show them personally what Truth is; they have absolute confidence in what man, "the president" tells them!

Was not this very spirit in the hearts of the men that rejected and crucified the Lord? Obviously this class of persons is not led by Truth, but by men of position. Such ones never ask, "Is it Truth?" but "By whom is it advocated?" And if it does not come from the channel through which they would have it to come, then, of course, Truth is rejected.

They never stop to think that God is not taking orders from them; that they are not choosing God's servants for Him, and that the General Conference president was elected by men, not because of his authority on the Scriptures, but because of his ability to command; that Truth as never yet originated through him, that whatever Bible truth he himself has ever learned is only that which inspired men of God have taught him. The laity, therefore, have never had greater need to cease from men as they have this day. And if they do not reform, God have pity on them.

It is to be remembered, though, that they are doing this foolish thing only because the ministry has so trained them, only because some ministers are in league with the spirit that was in Korah, Dathan, and Abiram when they aspired to the position of the prophets, although God has not delegated them as such.

Then, too, when a preacher begins broadcasting his good deeds and accomplishments, along with his religious experiences; also when a preacher rubs his eyes and blows his nose unnecessarily as he preaches and endeavors to make his audience start crying,—when you see these things in a preacher, know for certain that he is pulling the wool over the eyes of his listeners, that there is something up his sleeve. I say, when you see a preacher doing these things, he is aiming to enlist your endorsement to something of his own. Beware!

You may peruse the entire Bible, and I assure you that you will not find one of these things practiced by any of the prophets. They never aimed to make God's people sad, but always to rejoice in the Lord.

Take for example Jesus Christ. His work, His mission, was greater and more important than any before Him or after Him. He had religious experience that was worth telling, and if such a procedure would have been beneficial in the work of salvation, He certainly would have taken advantage of it. Instead of preaching Himself, though, He preached the Truth. He never tried to persuade anyone by

talking of Himself. He simply spoke of Bible truth, and gave God, not Himself, the credit. And if anyone can preach repentance and love, He could, but He never tried to play on the emotions of His audience, never tried to set them crying over anything.

No one, moreover, including ourselves, has ever accepted the writing of the prophets on merits of their goodness, their the education, or their personal religious experience. They wrote nothing concerning themselves, and nothing to bolster their office. All who have accepted them, have done so on the merits of their own writings. That is all. They never tried to win converts by what they themselves were or were not. Are they not to this day having success? And is it not the Truth of God that we must be after? The Jews asked for a sign, and the Greeks for wisdom, but God's people of today are asking for both sign and wisdom, rather then for Truth.

Let us, therefore, never forget that the spirit of self-exaltation originated all the evil which we see today, and which is harder at work than ever before. We should not give the Dragon a chance to trap us, and dump us into doom with the "third part of the angels" who took hold of his tail and could not let loose of it. Let us ever remember that—

"The lofty looks of man shall be humbled, and the haughtiness of men shall be bowed down, and the Lord alone shall be exalted in that day." Isa. 2:11. --2 Timely Greetings, No. 28

# GOD'S SOLUTION TO THE WACO/MOUNTAINDALE CONFLICT

Are you tired of the constant conflict between God's people over a place?--a conflict going on for nearly ten years. What has been the result?

- 1. Great loss of love among God's people.
- Loss of spirituality in many and ungodly rivalries.
- Great confusion in the field.
- 4. Loss of resources and time.
- 5. A diversion from the primary work God has given us--preparing ourselves and the church for the sealing and Ezekiel 9--the great and dreadful day of the Lord.
- 6. Worst of all is the loss of many souls who have abandoned all sides in the confusion.

Is Satan happy over all of this? Indeed! His satanic majesty is jubilant. Over many Davidians he virtually says: "These are my beloved sons in whom I am well pleased." He understands perfectly what the prophet meant by saying:

"Actually, now as in Moses' time, there are occasions when one is at a loss to know whether saints or devils are busily engaged in God's great work." 1 TG.9:13.

What is Satan's simple strategy? Divide and conquer God's people. In unity there is strength, but "a house divided against itself

cannot stand." He says: "Make other secondary issues a mountain of importance in their minds. Then set them so busy fighting each other over these issues, that they will have less time and money and focus for their most important duty (conquering the church). Let them seek to conquer each other instead, and boast about it.

"Destroy love and trust. Make them quick to misinterpret each others' words and motives and accuse of false doctrines. Fire them with zeal. Make them think that in doing all this (accusing and destroying of each other's influence and work) that they are serving Jesus faithfully and building His kingdom. When one goes to a field and does some work, let the others go behind him and work at cross purposes. This way the 'bridge' they are building to the God of justice will never be built. In short let them 'waste time'. Let them be more guilty of this since they were warned":

"With the end of the long journey in view, the work was never so great, the time in which to do it never so short, and the laborers never so few, as now. Self-evident, therefore, is the fact that Satan's supreme effort at this hour must be to cause the time to be wasted and the work to go undone."

1 Answerer: 68.

Beloved, while some may keep pushing this as a salvation issue, let's stop playing Satan's "blame game." Let not the "accuser of the brethren" number us in his army. Let us go directly to God's solution. We DO NOT NEED MAN'S SOLUTION. Why not?

Man's solutions are often schemes that are full of hidden agendas. God's solution is absolutely right and just and holy and wise.

WHAT IS GOD'S SOLUTION TO THE DESTRUCTIVE CONFLICT? Here it is--simple but omnipotent:

"If my people which are called by my name shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and forgive their sin, and heal their land." 2 Chronicles 7:14.

What must we do, as individuals, if God is to intervene and stop this destructive conflict. God's people must:

1. "Humble themselves." This means that as God's people we are proud and arrogant. This is the biggest part of the problem. Self is big and powerful and anything but dead.

"In most of the religious controversies the foundation of the trouble is that self is striving for the supremacy. About what? About matters which are not vital points at all, and which are regarded as such only because men have given importance to them. (See Matt. 12:31-37; Mark 14:56; Luke 5:21; Matt. 9:3)" TM:70.

- "And pray". Let's start praying directly to God to stop this time-wasting, Satan-helping conflict. Pray as individuals, pray as groups. Pray everyday about it and watch the Almighty work.
- 3. "Seek my face". This involves deliberate prayer sessions. Invest some time in this business if you love God's cause. Don't tell God what to do, just ask him to stop the conflict and glorify His name.
- 4. "Turn from their wicked ways". There are wicked things being done among God's people. Slander, double-crossing, politicking, bribing with higher wages, prevaricating, lying, etc.--all in the name of the Lord to help "conquer the city". Let's confess these things as wickedness and sins before the Lord. Let's do this individually. Ask God to refresh our memories about our own sins--worry not about those of the other side. Confess and turn away from our sins in Jesus' name.

When we do this what will the Great God of Heaven who "cannot lie" do? He gives His never-failing promise: "then will I hear from heaven, and forgive their sin, and heal their land."

OH WHAT A MIGHTY SOLUTION IS MADE AVAILABLE TO US! WE CAN STOP THE SELFISH MADNESS! LET GOD'S BRIDGE BE BUILT BY RIGHTEOUS MEN-WHO ARE NOT WORKING AT CROSS-PURPOSES.

"Christians are working at cross-purposes among themselves. One Christian brother is

betraying another. Christian ministers, rather than preaching the Truth, are preaching against one another. One goes ahead to build up, and another trails behind to tear down. They do not see eye to eye; nor do they understand one another even as much as did the confused tower-builders.

"Just so long as such selfishness and dishonesty, confusion and animosity, exist among Christians, their bridge and their tower, so to speak, will come to naugh as certainly as did the bridge of the six covenant-breakers and as did the tower of the prophet Noah's mockers." I TG.14:15.

Can we do these thing and expect to "conquer the city"? Does Christ ever seek to force men to unite with Him? Does not Davidia need healing today, brethren? Do we not need forgiveness, love and healing more than ever before? Then let us as individuals start praying on this very matter! Do not wait for any man's solution. Call daily upon the Omnipotent One.

Watch, beloved, watch. Watch and see how speedily the Almighty will work and defeat Satan. "The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much." "Again I say unto you, if two of you shall agree on earth as touching anything that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven." Matt. 18:19

### THE GOSPEL OF HEALTH

#### Vegetarians in Better Shape

A recent study funded by the Australian Meat Corporation, found that vegetarians and vegans are in much better shape than meat eaters: They're less likely to be overweight, have high blood pressure or high cholesterol.

Published in the European Journal of Clinical Nutrition (February 1999), the study's purpose was to assess the frequency of blood clots-known to be a major predictor of heart disease-in meat eaters compared with vegetarians.

Not surprisingly, the vegetarians exhibited far fewer risk factors for heart disease. But the researchers did uncover something noteworthy. Tests indicated that the vegetarians' blood was low in alpha-linoleic acid (ALA), commonly found in meat and fish. This can present certain problems, but it is known that meat isn't the only-or even the best--source of ALA. Vegetarians can reap the benefits of this important fatty acid by including flaxseed oil, soybeans and soy products, walnuts (a very rich source), pumpkin seeds and an abundance of leafy vegetables green in their diets. --Vegetarian Times, March 2000.

The "Genesis diet" continues to prove itself ideal for the human family. See Genesis 1:29 and 3:18.

#### **Eating Between Meals**

X-ray studies have been conducted to determine the emptying time of the normal stomach. Anything remaining in the stomach 5 hours after a meal is abnormal. The stomach usually empties itself in 2 1/2 to 4 hours. Series of test have been run in which persons have been given routine breakfasts consisting of cereal and cream, bread, cooked fruit, and an egg. These stomachs were X-rayed and found to be emptied normally in less than 4 1/2 hours.

A few days later these same persons were given the same type of breakfast. Two hours after breakfast one had an ice cream cone. He was found to have residues in his stomach after 6 hours. Another was given a peanut butter sandwich two hours after breakfast. He was found to have residues after 9 hours. A third was given a piece of pumpkin pie and a glass of milk two hours after breakfast. He was observed to have a large amount of residue after 9 hours. The fourth was given a half slice of bread and butter 1 1/2 hours after breakfast, repeated every 1 1/2 hours thereafter, but no dinner. It was found that more than half of his breakfast was still in his stomach after 9 hours.

The fifth subject was given a routine breakfast at 8:00 in the morning. Twice during the morning and twice during the

afternoon a bit of chocolate candy was given. At 9:30 that night, 13 1/2 hours after breakfast, more than one-half of the morning meal was still in the stomach.

It has been found that even a little peanut nibbling delays digestion to the extent that 11 hours after breakfast there is still a large residue left in the stomach. This sort of routine insults the human mechanism, destroys its normal function, and lessens the efficiency of mind, body, and emotions. Many of the chemicals produced during partial digestion are toxic, such as aldehydes, alcohols, and esters. These cause an intoxication of brain, liver, kidneys, and other delicate tissues.

Probably the key to regularity in eating lies in having a good breakfast. When the morning meal is omitted, one tends to become hungry before noon, and resorts to a snack. The snack slackens the appetite for lunch, less is eaten, but before long hunger returns. Snacking in the afternoon seems to be the logical solution. There is no desire for food at 6:00 so dinner is delayed until later. Then there may be more snacking before retiring. At bedtime much food remains only partially digested to prevent the digestive organs from benefiting from the sleep. One arises, having slept the sleep of the drugged, but unrefreshed.

The best routine is to eat breakfast within three hours of arising, wait at least five hours before having lunch, and preferably six to 7 hours. Again, wait five hours before supper, and have a light

supper of fruit and grains, taken several hours before bedtime. If at all possible the third meal, even though only of fruit and grain, should be omitted entirely. It may take several months (up to six) to develop the habit of omitting the evening meal. Those who have the stamina to persist will find it a great benefit to the life to have the extra strength which would be expended in digesting the third meal. —The Missing Link, by Dr. Jay M. Hoffman

Inspiration says: "In many cases the faintness that leads to a desire for food is felt because the digestive organs have been too severely taxed during the day. After disposing of one meal, the digestive organs need rest. At least 5 or 6 hours should intervene between the meals...." Counsels on Diet and Foods, p. 173.

"I am astonished to learn that, after all the light that has been given in this place, many of you eat between meals! You should never let a morsel pass your lips between your regular meals. Eat what you ought, but eat it at one meal, and then wait until the next." Ibid. p. 180.

"Three meals a day and nothing between meals—not even an apple—should be the utmost limit of indulgence. Those who go further violate nature's laws and will suffer the penalty." —CDF: 182

#### THE MIRACLE BERRY

The amazing little blueberry has emerged as nature's number one source of antioxidants among fresh fruits and vegetables.

In tests at the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Human Nutrition Research Center on Aging at Tufts University in Boston, blueberries beat out 39 other common fruits and vegetables in antioxidant power-even such heavyweights as kale, strawberries, spinach, and broccoli. Much of that power comes literally "out of the blue"--from anthocyanins, the pigments that give blueberries their deep blue hue. Blueberries are bursting with them.

So impressed is Ronald Prior, Ph.D., head of the USDA Phytochemical Laboratory at Tufts and the scientist who discovered the secret power of blueberries, that he now recommends adding 1/2 cup of blueberries to the diet every day. "With 1/2 cup of blueberries, you can just about double the amount of antioxidants most Americans get in one day. If you want to slow down the free radical aging process, blueberries are the leader of the pack," he says.

Every second of our lives, our cells are bombarded by dangerous particles called free radicals. They can alter our DNA in ways that cause cancer. Or change LDL cholesterol (the bad cholesterol) so it sticks to artery walls. Or damage collagen and make skin

wrinkle-prone. Over time, these kinds of changes can accelerate the aging process. Fortunately, we can fight back with antioxidants—the natural zappers of free radicals—by eating lots of fruits and vegetables. And blueberries are emerging as the king of the antioxidants.

Just like their cousin the cranberry, blueberries contain compounds that can prevent urinary tract infections (UTIs). Called condensed tannins, they can keep the bacteria responsible for UTIs from attaching to the wall of the bladder.

In Japan, blueberries are known as "the vision fruit"--reputed to help relieve eyestrain--and blueberry sales there have quadrupled in the last several years. European blueberries (bilberries) have been shown to improve night vision and help eyes adjust to bright lights.

The most intriguing news about blueberries is that there's a possibility they can actually reverse the loss of short-term memory that happens as we age. This according to James Joseph, Ph.D., a USDA scientist at Tufts, who along with his family has begun eating blueberries regularly.

Strawberries, raspberries, and black-berries, as well as other colorful fruits and vegetables--are also loaded with antiaging antioxidants and healing nutrients and should form a major part of a healthful diet. —Adapted from Prevention, June 1999.
