Global Warming - A Warning?

DID you know that the global temperature has been rising dangerously over the past few decades? This is definitely so and responsible scientists are now sounding the voice of alarm everywhere. What is the cause of this new danger? And what grave problems are likely to afflict the planet as the earth's global temperature continues to soar?

The cause of global warming is essentially due to the effect of the greenhouse gases we burn in our modern, industrialized society, releasing vast quantities of carbon dioxide in the atmosphere. Among the catastrophic problems we can expect to see are:

- -- More droughts in the southern regions of the earth.
- --More floods and downpours in the northern regions of the earth.
- -- More diseases as harmful insects, like

mosquitoes and flies, multiply an spread with the warming climates, to places where the cold heretofore, forbad and killed them.

- --Many adorable (like the polar bears, penguins, sea birds) and beneficial animal species will become extinct quickly disappearing from the planet. Fierce heat waves afflicting various parts of the planet.
- --More powerful storms/hurricanes/ typhoons devastating cities, towns and villages.
- -- More tsunamis and rising sea levels that are dangerously high.
- -- The Greenland Ice Sheet, two miles thick at the center can potentially raise the world's oceans 23 feet high, is melting dangerously fast.

Before we read more of these points in

the actual words of concerned scientists, it is timely to recall the bible prediction made about two thousand years ago: "In the last days perilous times shall come. . ." 2 Tim. 3:1, and that God will also destroy "them that destroy the earth." Rev. 11:18. Now listen to these ominous bells of alarm from respected scientists.

Scientists Bill Blakemore speaks out: "NEW YORK, FEB. 3, 2007—The findings in the new report are sobering enough – that the world's scientist agree global warming is "unequivocal" and irreversible: Manmade greenhouse gases are shooting up – driving the rise in earth's temperature and sea level, and the decline in earth's snow cover.

"But there's a massive unknown worrying the scientists: Sea levels could rise in the coming decades faster than anyone thought.

"Ominous news in the fourth unanimous assessment in 20 years by the IPCC [Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change], just finalized at a plenary session in Paris, sets the stage: the human-induced warming has now reached down more than a mile to normally frigid deep ocean currents—currents that for millions of years have acted as a massive cooling system for the planet.

"Water expands as it heats up, so scien-

tists can now calculate that sea level will rise up between seven inches and nearly two feet before the end of the century.

"But there is also an enormous wild card: It's the Greenland Ice Sheet, two miles thick at tits center and containing enough ice to raise the world's oceans 23 feet. It is melting so fast that scientists in Paris couldn't settle any on predictions for it."

Another scientist writes:

Global Warming's Extinction Threat "No natural climate cycles can explain the heat. It must be caused, in large measure at least, by manmade green-house-gas emissions, NASA scientists said.

"As for humans, new studies in the journal Nature have confirmed the World Health Organization estimates that, conservatively, 150,000 more people die each year—and five million more get sick—because manmade global warming is helping insect and water-borne diseases to spread, especially among poorer nations.

"Scientists in the tropics have reported that warming is drying forests, spurring a growing number of extinctions, and threatening even the many species of wild orchids that rely on near-constant mist in the cloud forests.

"If it gets any warmer, I don't see how

extinction can be avoided," said Karen Masters' an American scientist working on wild orchids in Costa Rica's Monte Verde Cloud Forest. . . .

"At this winter's worldwide global-warming conference in Montreal, the U.S. came under a great deal of criticism from almost all the other countries for refusing to participate in any formal discussions about how to try to cut greenhouse emissions, and how to try to slow the warming that has already started to disrupt so much life around the world."

Amy Goodman, another scientist writes:

"While the rest of the world accepts the reality of global warming, the U.S., the world's largest producer of greenhouse gases, has been stymied by the disinformation campaigns of the oil industry. Let's hope the new 110th Congress shifts climate-change policy at a glacial pace the rapidly receding 21st-century glaciers, that is. Key committees will be chaired by Sen. Barbara Boxer, D-Calif., and Rep. John Dingell, D-Mich. Replacing chairman Sen. James Inhofe, R-Okla., who describes global warming as a hoax, Boxer is bullish on fighting greenhouse gases. Dingell, from the heart to the auto industry in Michigan, is less direct and hedges on his willingness, for example to push for better fuel efficiency in cars."

As a child I often wondered over the bible statement regarding "them which "destroy the earth." Rev. 11:18. I puzzled over the question: "How could men destroy the earth?" Today more than ever: through chemical pollution of air, land and sea; through de-forestation which affects the weather and promotes soil erosion and impoverishment through global warming, wars and other evils even a child can painfully see that the planet is being poisoned and destroyed and that therefore God must intervene very soon, because only an omnipotent God can stop the mad rush to destruction at every level?

Inspiration says:

"Manifest, too, is the certainty that Heaven has permitted these instruments of destruction to come in order to rouse Christendom, ministry and laity alike, to a concerted, enlightened, all-out action as the Lord leads ahead to save man from himself and from the Devil. Christianity failing this task, and leaving the world to save itself as best it can, the Enemy will ere long wipe out not only the knowledge of God and of salvation but also civilization itself. . . ." WHR p.

".... Will not all Christians everywhere be aroused by these things to "put on

the whole armour of God" and to "take.

. the sword of the Spirit" (Eph. 6:11,
17) while following the Lord as He leads ahead? If not, then certain it is that the Church and the World as well are hopelessly doomed. To be sure, though, the few who do arouse to make the total surrender which the hour demands, God will save from, the conflagration to come." WHR pp. 9, 10.

"Perilous times are before us. Everyone who has a knowledge of the truth should awake and place himself, body, soul, and spirit, under the discipline of God. The enemy is on our track. We must be wide awake, on our guard against him. We must put on the whole armor of God. We must follow the directions given through the spirit of prophecy. We must love and obey the truth for this time." 8T 298.

Indeed let us recognize global warming as a sign telling us that the kingdom is at the door.

At this point another darker and more dreadful pollution looms up in view. In fact the global pollution, frightening as it is, is just another grim reminder of this uglier and deadlier pollution that like a shroud of death devastates planet earth – the moral and spiritual pollution of sin. Yes, is it not sin that is the real cause of the woes and evils that curse the planet? Are we therefore putting sin out

of our lives? Are we putting away our idols? Are we, as Jesus instructs us to do, cutting off the right hand and digging out the right eye that causes us to sin? Are we doing our God-given work (sighing and crying) that the kingdom may soon be established and the earth renewed, where no global warming or pollution of any type shall mar or curse our everlasting habitations, and where the inhabitants shall never say I am sick? Let us indeed say, beloved brethren by words and actions, "Thy kingdom come."

"The Times of the Gentiles" Fulfilled

1. What did Christ say concerning "the times of the Gentiles"? Luke 21:24

Note: As previously mentioned in the note under question two, page 12, God has not taken nor will He take the unbelieving Jews back to Jerusalem or Palestine, because of their rejection of Christ. Furthermore, because of their wickedness in their rejection of the prophets, the ten tribe kingdom, and later the two tribe kingdom, were cast out of their land. See 2 Kings 17:5-24; 2 Chron. 36:14-21

- 2. When the Lord returns the captivity of His people (Joel 3:1,2) will sinners dwell among them? Joel 3:16,17; Zech. 14:21; Ezek. 20:38.
- 3. After the latter rain falls (Joel 2:23) where will deliverance be found? Joel


2:32; Micah 5:7; Zech. 8:19-23; Obad. 17,21

4. At what time will the Lord gather all nations "down into the valley of Jehoshaphat"? Joel 3:1,2

Note: The very first word ("for") of chapter three shows that the prophecy of chapter two continues through chapter three.

These verses explain why, how, and when God's people are delivered in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem. These things, you see, are to take place when He brings again the captivity of Judah and Jerusalem. Then shall He bring all the nations into the valley of Jehoshaphat and there plead for all His captive people whom the nations have scattered throughout the world.

5. What reveals the vile practices of the heathen? Joel 3:3



- 6. What will be the reward and recompense of those who have scattered God's people? Joel 3:4-8
- 7. When these prophecies are being fulfilled, for what will the nations be preparing? Joel 3:9,10
- 8. When the heathen assemble Whose presence (though invisible) will be there? Joel 3:11. Compare Isaiah 13:3-6; 31:14, 5; Zech. 2:5, 10-13.
- 9. Where will God judge the people? Joel 3:12-14.

Note: Yes, here is described the day of decision. The multitudes will then have to decide either to serve God and live or to continue serving the Devil and perish with him.

10. Describe the day we are approaching. Joel 3:15,16; 2:1,2,10,11

Note: What a day the world is now approaching, and how blind to the fact is the church herself!

11. Where will our final cleansing take place? Joel 3:17-21

Note: The statement- "then shall Jerusalem be holy, and there shall no strangers pass through her anymore" - should clearly

indicate to the candid student that this Jerusalem is not in heaven.

Our final cleansing is to be in our own land. The scriptures, you see, are correlated; one truth explains another. Verses and chapters, therefore, cannot be isolated from their context if they are rightly to be understood. A correct idea cannot be built upon any one verse when isolated from its continuity. And only when we take God at His Word can we in truth study the Scriptures. Then we need but the key word to unlock the mysteries of God. And here we have it.

12. At what time does God make His people "a name and a praise among all people of the earth?" Zeph. 3:17-20; Zech. 3:8; Isa. 24:16; 49:23; 61:4-9; 62:2,3,12.

Note: Agair. we see that "the times of the Gentiles" will be fulfilled (Luke 21:24) when God "shall bring again the captivity of Judah and Jerusalem." "For the Lord their God shall visit them, and turn away their captivity." (Joel 3:1; Zeph. 2:7)

And now, fellow student, as you continue to "prove all things" and to "hold fast that which is good" the truth will become even more clear on the prophecies of

The Setting up of the Kingdom.

- 1. How long were God's people to be without a kingdom? Hosea 3:4. After "many days" what are they to do? verse 5
- 2. Give another reference that predicted the destruction of the ancient kingdom. Amos 9: 8. What promise was made to the house of Jacob, or Israel? verse 8, last part, verse 9.
- 3. What will happen to the sinners among God's people? Amos 9:10. In that day what will the Lord do? verse 11. Compare Hosea 2:15
- 4. Whom will God's people possess? Amos 9:12. Compare Zeph. 2:9, last part; Obadiah 17-21; Num.24:17-19; Isa. 14:1,2

- 5. How did Micah predict the downfall of Zion and Jerusalem? Micah 3:12. Did the prophecy come to pass? How did he describe the restoration of Zion and Jerusalem? Micah 4:1. Will this, then, also come to pass?
- 6. From where will the gospel message go forth at that time? Micah 4:2, last part What will the converted nations do? verses 2-5. Compare Isa. 60:3-11; Zech. 8:19-23
- 7. To whom will the kingdom come? Micah 4:8
- 8. When does Daniel say the kingdom will be set up? Dan. 2:44. By what is the kingdom symbolized? Dan. 2:34,44
- 9. Out of what is the stone cut? Dan. 2:45. After the stone (kingdom) smites the image what does it become? Dan. 2:34,44. Of what is a mountain symbolical? Zech. 8:3; Isa. 56:6,7; Dan. 9:20.
- 10. How will the daughter of Zion (the descendants of God's ancient people-the kingdom church) have a part in the breaking (separating) of the nations? Micah 4:11-13. Compare Isa. 41:14-16' 60:12; Jer.51:19-23; Joel 2:1-11; Micah 5:7-9.
- 11. How is Daniel's interpretation of

the "stone" reinforced in Zechariah 12? Zech. 12:1-3,9. Compare verses 4-8 with Zech. 10:5,6; 14:14.

Note: You will notice from these scriptures that (1) The kingdom (the stone) is set up before it smites the nations; (2) It is cut out of the mountain without hands, by a miracle, by the Lord Himself; (3) That after it smites the image it grows into a great mountain and finally fills the whole earth. It is obvious that the threshing or the separating of the nations is in the time of the harvest, the time in which there are both wheat and chaff to be separated.

"Clad in the armour of Christ's righteousness, the church is to enter her final conflict. 'Fair as the moon, clear as the sun, and terrible as an army with banners,' she is to go forth into all the world, conquering and to conquer." -Prophets and Kings, p.725

"And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be delivered: for in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem shall be deliverance, as the Lord hath said, and in the remnant whom the Lord shall call." Joel 2:32

In words so simple that a child can understand, and so plain that "the way-faring men, though fools, shall not err therein" (Isa.35:8), the Scriptures further show

The Reason for the Kingdom.

- 1. What promise did God make to Abraham? 1 Chron. 16:16-18. Will He keep this promise? Ezek. 20:37, last part; Micah 7:20; Amos 9:11-15.
- 2. What was Jeremiah told to write in a book? Why? Jer. 30:1-3, 17-20.
- 3. What time of trouble do God's people go through on their way back to their homeland? Jer. 30:4-7 What definitely shows that after being punished (Jer. 30:11-15) they will again become a kingdom, with their own king and ruler? Jer. 30:8-11,21,22.
- 4. What is to fall upon the wicked? Whose intention is it to restore the kingdom? Jer. 30:23,24. Do you believe the Lord will do what He says He will do? When will God's people consider it? Verse 24, last part.

Note: The fact that the forgoing prophecies of the restoration of the kingdom during probationary time have not been fulfilled, and the fact that the Lord declared that He will bring them to pass should be sufficient evidence for faith; however, some ask the question:

Are the Promises of the Kingdom conditional?

1. How positive is the Lord concern-

ing His promises? Jer. 31:35-37; 33:20-26.

Note: Jeremiah chapter thirty-one is continuation of chapter thirty, showing the return of God's people to their own land, and the kingdom restored. It also shows their punishment while among the Gentiles.

- 2. What are the nations admonished to hear and say? Jer. 31:10.
- 3. When God's people dwelt in their own land, what kind of people were they? Ezek. 36:16-21.
- 4. Why, then, does the Lord promise to take them back in our day? Ezek. 36:22-24, 31,3 2.
- 5. Where, and when, does the heart operation take place? Ezek. 36:24-28, 33; Jer. 312:31-34.
- 6. Besides a spiritual restoration, what will happen to the land? Ezek. 36:29, 33-36.
- 7. How dependable are these promises? Ezek. 36:36, last part, 37,38; Jer. 30:24; 33:20-26; Num. 23:19.
- 8. Who will still be "round about" God's people when these events take place? Ezek. 36:36.

Note: When this kingdom is finally established all nations will see as a reality that which they have, independent of God, been trying to established.

Widespread apprehension About the Future

that something great and decisive is about to take place – that the world is on the verge of a stupendous crisis. *PK* 537 (c.1914).

The calamities by land and sea, the unsettled state of society, the alarms of war, are portentous. They forecast approaching events of the greatest magnitude. The agencies of evil are combining their forces and consolidating. They are strengthening for the last great crisis. Great changes are soon to take place in our world, and the final movements will



be rapid ones.9T:11 (1909).

Troublous Times Soon To Come

The time of trouble, which is to increase until the end, is very near at hand. We have no time to lose. The world is stirred with the spirit of war. The prophecies of the eleventh of Daniel have almost reached their final fulfillment. RH Nov. 24, 1904

The time of trouble – trouble such as was not since there was a nation [Dan. 12:1] – is right upon us, and we are like the sleeping virgins. We are to awake and ask the Lord Jesus to place underneath us His everlasting arms, and carry us through the time of trial before us. 2MR 305 (1906)

The world is becoming more and more lawless. Soon great trouble will arise among the nations – trouble that will not cease until Jesus comes. RH Feb. 11, 1904.

We are on the very verge of the time of trouble, and perplexities that are scarcely dreamed of are before us. 9T 43 (1909)

We are standing on the threshold of the crisis of the ages. In quick succession the judgments of God will follow one another – fire, and flood, and earthquake, with war and bloodshed. *PK 278* (c.1914).

There are stormy times before us, but let us not utter one word of unbelief or discouragement. *ChS. 136 (1905)*

God Has Always Warned of Coming Judgments

God has always given men warning of coming judgments. Those who had faith in His message for their time, and who acted out their faith in obedience to His commandments, escaped the judgments that fell upon the disobedient and unbelieving.

The word came to Noah, "Come thou and all thy house into the ark; for thee have I seen righteous before Me." Noah obeyed and was saved. The message came to Lot, "Up, get you out of this place; for the Lord will destroy this city" (Gen. 7:1; 19:14). Lot placed himself under the guardianship of the heavenly messengers and was saved. So Christ's disciples were given warning of the destruction of Jerusalem. Those who watched for the sign of the coming ruin, and fled from the city, escaped the destruction. So now we are given warning of Christ's second coming and of the destruction to fall upon the world. Those who heed the warning will be saved. DA 634 (1898)

How Important Is Time?

Eccles. 9:10, 11 – "Whatsoever thy hand findeth to do, do it with thy might; for there is no work, nor device, nor knowledge, nor wisdom, in the grave, whether thou goest. I returned, and saw under the sun, that the race is not to the swift, nor the battle to the strong, neither yet bread to the wise, nor yet riches to men of understanding, nor yet favor to men of skill; but time and chance happeneth to them all.

Whatever duty we are called upon to perform, we must do it diligently with 100% of our might in order to get it done right and on time. All of you have heard it said many times that "if a thing is worth doing at all it is worth doing right." Still even though it be done perfectly it is done late it may never be of any value; and what we leave undone will be undone forever so far as we are concerned.

Eccles. 9:11 – "I returned, and saw under the sun, that the race is not to the swift, nor the battle to the strong, neither yet bread to the wise, nor yet riches to men of understanding, nor yet favour

to men of skill; but time and chance happeneth to them all."

Everyone has time. Everyone has chance. The winner of the race is not victorious simply because he was born to be swift, but it is because of the meeting of time and chance in his life. No, it was not just natural for him to win the race. In order for him to win he first had to spend the necessary time to fit himself for the race, and then the chance to run came. The same principle holds true in every field of endeavor. One must first study to fit himself for duty while he has the time in which to do it and then comes his opportunity to demonstrate or use what he has learned. The successful man, then, makes good use of his time and then watches and avails himself of his opportunity to serve when it presents itself. For instance, Abraham Lincoln, in his spare time, learned to be President of this country, and so when his chance came he was ready to fill the office admirably. To make a success in anything more must start out by mastering the most elementary fundamentals and then keep on progressing in advancement step by step.

Honest men who gain wealth do not do it because they naturally knew a great deal or were naturally skillful. It is because they used well their time and their chance. They, too, had put forth the necessary effort to equip and train themselves to be successful when their chance came. Those who do not make profitable use of their time cannot possibly live successfully.

Nobody can tell just what electricity is. And what about time? What is time? – Nobody here knows.

In the beginning, "the evening and the morning were the first day." Day is a measurement of time, and God created it. The day, as you know, is composed of twenty-four hours, an hour being merely a shorter measurement of


time. Since the earth can measure but twenty-four hours each time it turns on its axis, Earth, then, has as its only means of time measurement its rotation on its axis, and its circuit through its orbit. Do you realize that were it not for this we would be without time? Instead, it would be eternity. Therefore eternity has no time. Time is manufactured. Daniel refers to "time, times, and half a span measured by the completion of a full round of the earth in its orbit. That is one time. The repetition of it makes times. Then what is eternity? It has no measurement, for it is never to repeat itself like the years do. Time is given us that we may know what part of eternity man has existed on this earth.

Which do you think is the more important: time or eternity? – Time is every-

thing, for without it there is no eternity; still eternity is not time because it cannot be measured. Time saved is even more important than money saved, for you cannot save money if you do not save time.

If earth, through its constant movement and change of location in the universe, represents time, then everything might represent time. Plants represent

sent time, for you can tell by its size how old a plant is. In another form human beings represent time. Trees represent time by their growth. The Bible represents time, for it took time for man to live the history It records, to write It, to print It, to manufacture the paper on which It is printed and the machinery that prints It, to grow and process the material for Its cover, - it all represents



time. The workman's wages represent time paid in money. Neither gold or diamonds are obtained without the representation of the time element being present both in the commodities themselves and again in the money that people give in change for them.

Through this discussion you can see that time is vitally connected with material though it is invisible. It is far more important to save time, for time is priceless; it is just like salvation. But the sad fact is that but few people realize how valuable time is. In view of the great value of time what sin it must be to waste it! Yet to all are given time and

by eliminating useless and unnecessary effort. In that way our endurance is lengthened and we can actually accomplish more. Since it does take time and effort to talk, for instance, we should avoid useless talk, and learn to make every word count for good only. Lost time can never be recovered regardless of how we wasted it. It is gone for eternity. Therefore how valuable time is!

We should perhaps ask ourselves this question more often than any other; Am I doing something now that I may regret in eternity? And if we are we should at once set about to substitute worthy pur-

suits for the useless or worthless one. The Christian's

chance.

One hundred years there are about 36,500 days. In a general sense that amount in terms of dollars is not much, for today money is measured by billions of dollars. But a person's lifetime is in reality very short, and composed of three periods: childhood, prime, and old age. It is usually in his prime period of life that man is most productive, and since it is but a part of his lifetime, he should never waste a minute of that time. We should see that we get 100% value out of every minute we live. To accom-

great duty is to accomplish the things that God wants done. Doing that makes us right in one way or another. Should a man then rob us, God will reimburse us. Really, no one can cheat us if we engage ourselves in doing the things God wants done, but the man who tends only his own interests never actually gets very far, especially when his accomplishments are evaluated in the light of eternity. And "there is no limit to the good a man can do if he does not care who gets the credit."

Chance is what brings us eternity.

Therefore, if we make use of time and

chance, we do not have to worry about eternity.

Are you personally aware that time and chance are given to each of us, and that if we would be successful now and in the hereafter we must as judiciously invest our time as we would our money? Are you a time spendthrift": or a time wizard? Are you just existing, or are you preparing for your great "chance"? Each must answer this question for himself. Soon that great chance will come to every soul, and when it comes it will prove the faithfulness or the unfaithfulness of our stewardship over the time that was given us to prepare for it. As you stand now, are you ready?

"Our time belongs to God. Every moment is His, and we are under the most solemn obligation to improve it to His glory ... Of no talent He has given will he require a more strict account than of our time.

"... We shall individually be held responsible for doing one jot less than we have ability to do. The Lord measures with exactness every possibility for service. The unused capabilities are as much brought into account as are those that are improved. For all that we might become through the right use of our talents God holds us responsible. We shall be judged according to what we ought to have done, but did not accomplish

'Whatsoever thy hand findeth to do, do it with thy might,' 'knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for ye serve the Lord Christ.'" – Christ's Object Lessons, (1941 edition) pp. 342, 363, 346; (1900 edition) pp. 345,365, 349.

In the day that we must account for our stewardship WE WILL BE ABLE TO GIVE A GOOD ACCOUNT OF EVERY OTHER TALENT ENTRUSTED TO US IF WE CAN SHOW THAT WE HAVE MADE THE MOST PROFITABLE USE OF OUR TIME. That is how important time is. May God help each of us to be wise time investors.

What is Religion?

Question No. 109:

Does religion consist only of studying and praying, fasting and weeping, preaching and comforting, repenting and forgiving, begging and giving? How can one become religious, and what difference will it make in one's life?

Answer:

Just as the Great Exemplar of Bible religion was the word (Son) of God in human form (1John 1:1), so Bible religion itself is the commandments (right-

And as such, they are to be skilled in the science of management, employing thousands of aliens, not only to minister to their needs and to build (Isa. 60:10), but also to "stand and feed" their flocks and to be their plowmen and vinedressers (Isa. 61:5). Thus it is that the "study in agricultural lines should be A, B, and C of the education given in our schools." - Testimonies, Vol. 6, p. 179. "Pure, practical religion will be manifested in treating the earth as God's treasure

Besides being skilled agronomists, artisans, and tradesmen, these governors of the Kingdom as living embodiments of genuine Christianity, are to be expert international bankers, economists, personnel and traffic engineers, and provisioners, together handling "the forces" and "the riches of the Gentiles." Isa. 6:5, 11; 61:6. And thus variously equipped with these excellent proficiencies, they are, above all, to be "Priests of the Lord ... Ministers of our God." – "men wondered at." Isa. 61:6; Zech. 3:8.

The gospel minister is accordingly to be decently informed in the practical pur-

suits of life and to be expert in at least one thing. Certainly any preacher getting ten per cent (the tithe) of a farmer's income, should study to become capable of helping him to improve his farming methods in a practical way should ever the occasion arise. In short, he should be competent to assist the member so his church in organizing, correcting, or improving their work and business., Jesus taught His disciples not only to pray, to preach and practice the Truth, to give and forgive, but also to serve, to fish, to feed and clothe, and to pay bills in a business-like way. (See Matthew 5:5-13; 10:5-7, 27; 5:19, 10:15; 18:21, 22; 20:25-28; Mark 6:35-41; Like 22:7-13; John 21:3-6; Matthew 25:31-45; 17:24-27.)

But to be such a Christian, a truly religious person, one must first of all organize his entire being, rightly controlling, coordinating, and using his strength, his energy, his means, and his time. Anyone who fails to effect this integrated fourfold economy of being, can never achieve any true success. To do so, he must get "sixty seconds worth of distance run out of each unforgiving minute," sixty minutes of maximum application and accomplishment out of every working or resting hour, and peak effectiveness out of every move or stroke. He must, in short, eliminate every wasted motion, as well as every thoughtless, circuitous duplication and overlapping

of motions, which bring no results but only deplete his stock of reserve energy. The work of such an altogether-Christian will never be found done in a bunglesome or hit-and-miss fashion.

Furthermore, he is never found living in excess of his means, but so carefully budgeting his income as to enable him to live within his means and also regularly to lay aside a little in reserve for a rainy day. He shuns contracting debts; he knows that the habit of ever borrowing and never being able to pay back, is a species of robbery – lying.

Such a one, whether poor or rich, never fears the future. He unpresumptuously trusts in the Lord for his daily needs; he never has a worried thought "for the morrow." Matt. 6:27-34.

All in all, we see that Bible religion,
Christianity, is nothing more or less than
turning from obeying the devil, to obeying the Lord, turning from a life of
doing wrong to a life of doing right, from consuming to producing; from
borrowing to loaning; from begging to
giving; from cheating to restoring and to
dealing honestly; from exacting to forgiving; and from being served to serving.

"True religion is ever distinctly seen in our words and deportment, and in every act of life. With the followers of Christ, religion should never be divorced from business. They should go hand in hand and God's commandments should be strictly regarded in all the details of worldly matters. The knowledge that we are children of God should give a high tone of character even to the everyday duties of life, making us not slothful in business, bur fervent in spirit. Such a religion as this bears the scrutiny of a critical world with a grand consciousness of integrity." Testimonies, Vol. 4, pp. 190, 191.

"Christianity has a much broader meaning than many have hitherto given it. It is not a creed. It is the word of Him who liveth and abideth forever. It is a living, animating principle, that takes possession of mind, heart, motives, and the entire man. Christianity – O that we might experience its operations! It is a vital, personal experience, that elevates and ennobles the whole man."

Testimonies ... Ministers, pp. 421, 422.

All this is what the religion of Christ is, and he who practices it, has true charity (1 Cor. 13) – is truly "born again."

To say it again, every true Christian first organizes himself, then his family, and then his business. And what is more, he learns through it all that some can be organized, while others cannot; that some labor to achievement, while others labor to naught; that some produce, while others only consume; that some

are always giving like the maple tree, while others are always taking like the dry sponge; that some bless the world with good, while others live and labor for self and think, that all others should live and labor for them; that some quietly practice their religion, while others make a display of holiness by much religious talk and prayer, but few corresponding works, and that some know both when to visit and when not to visit, while others know neither the time to visit nor the time take leave, and have to be pried loose like barnacles once they are seated! What a jungle is the preacher's problem!

Second Tithe: Do I Need To Return It?

There are brethren who expressed their sentiments about returning second tithe; they have no problem returning the first tithe but have questions like, what about the Second Tithe: Do I need to return it?

Let me wish and hope for you a blessed and a prosperous year. With the coming of this new year, we can thank God that He brought us through the year 2006 and pray that He will help us to meet the challenges of the year 2007.

Overcoming the potentially devastating events of the 2005 special session, has in many ways been a huge challenge for the Association. But thank God for those of you who continued to support the work with your prayers, encouragement, and financial gifts.

Your efforts have been invaluable in sustaining the work through this most difficult time. It is our earnest prayer that you have not, and will not allow the clouds of the special session to obscure the sunlight of our Savior's love and



loose your faith and your hold on Christ. After all, we have been warned that "every thing that can be shaken will be shaken." MYP 30.

So, dear brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might.

Determine more than ever to draw closer still closer to His Word and rest and work in His love.

We know that you must be experiencing personal trials, troubles, stresses and temptations. But we ask you, please do not give up. Pray more fervently. Cling tighter to God's Word and His love. And please remember the Association and its efforts to provide truth-filled literature, cassettes, CD's and workers to proclaim this most precious truth. Not that the Lord cannot fulfill His work without us, but that He has ordained that we have a crucial part to play in this grand cause. God wants our earnest prayers, our faith, our best efforts and our resources. Yes it is His command and our privilege to do our utmost in promulgating the truth.

One of the most important part that we can do, among others, is the returning of a consistent second tithe.

Unfortunately, over the past years, the second tithe income has been very low.

Because of this, the 2006 session mandated that the Executive Council remind and encourage us to contribute not only a first tithe, but also a faithful second

tithe as outlined by Inspiration. This fund is very much needed if the Association is to continue its work.

SECOND TITHE: WHAT IS IT?

We know that the first tithe is ten percent of our earnings, or what the Scriptures refer to as "increase." The Lord commanded Israel to "truly tithe all the increase of thy seed, that the field bringeth forth year by year."

Deuteronomy 14:22. The word "increase" refers to our profits, not our gross, but our income after our investments. In other words, we are commanded to give a tithe (ten percent) of our net earnings.

We are all familiar with the uses of the first tithe. We know that it is to be used toward the direct support of the gospel, which includes the publications and sustaining those who proclaim it. (See Testimonies for the Church, Vol.9 pp 246-250). The Symbolic Codes support this: "The Ministerial Department," Inspiration declared, — workers and Present Truth publication — shall be maintained by the first tithe." (The Symbolic Code Vol. 4, Nos. 1-3, p. 4).

But what about the second tithe?
"Bring ye all the tithes into the store-house, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith,

saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it."

Malachi 3:10

"Under no other conditions does He promise His blessings. You have hard luck? You cannot make ends meet? Start paying your tithes. Notice carefully that God requires not only tithe but tithes; that is, tithe and free will offering." Timely Greetings, Vol.2 No. 30, p. 19. This tells us that God requires a first and a second tithe. The second, however, is used as you would general offerings. That is, the first is used for the support of the gospel but, as we will see, the second is used as general offerings. However, note that this second tithe is a required contribution unlike strictly voluntary offerings.

"Though the Lord commands, 'Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse' (Mal 3:10). He does not say to bring all the offerings. Thus He shows that if we would engage in some personal charity or missionary activity, we would sustain it from offerings, not from tithe." The Answerer Book, No. 4 p. 45.

There is clear evidence that God requires a second tithe. This fund is also crucial for the work, because it supports those phases of the work for which the first tithe cannot legitimately be used. So,

where is the evidence for a second tithe? "And thou shalt eat before the LORD thy God, in the place which He shall choose to place His name there, the tithe of thy corn, of thy wine, and of thine oil, and firstlings of thy herbs and of thy flocks. At the end of three years thou shalt bring forth all the tithe of thine increase the same year, and shalt lay it up within thy gates. And the Levite, (because he hath no part nor inheritance with thee) and the stranger, and the fatherless, and the widow, which are within thy gates, shall come, and shall eat and be satisfied: that the LORD thy God may bless thee in all the work of thine hand which thou doest." Deuteronomy 14:23, 28,29.

"To promote the assembling of the people, for religious service, as well as to provide for the poor, a second tithe of all the increase was required Every third year, however, this second tithe was to be used at home, in entertaining the Levite and the poor... This tithe would provide a fund for the uses of charity and hospitality." Patriarchs and Prophet, p. 530

Thus, the second tithe was a second ten percent to support the areas of the work that the first could not.

USES OF THE SECOND TITHE

As we have just seen, the second tithe

was used to support the assembling of the people for religious service and to provide for the poor. (Patriarchs and Prophets, p. 530). In other words, it takes care of buildings, the general operations, and the needs of the poor. In short, it constitutes our general offerings and benevolent fund. (Answerer Book, No. p.63). This means that the second tithe supports all the functions and areas of the Association for which the first tithe cannot be used. This would include things such as the general office, building maintenance, sessions and general meetings, some aspects of DLI, and of course, the Benevolent Department.

As you can see, this fund is crucially important to the continuance of the work of God.

HOW TO RETURN SECOND TITHE

In short, the second tithe is returned after the first tithe is deducted from your increase. "If one's income is \$15 a week, then his first tithe will amount to \$1.50, and his second tithe on the remaining \$13.50 will amount to \$1.35. Thus, his first and second tithe on \$15 increase will total \$2.85." The Answerer Book," No. 4, p. 52

"In cases where it is impossible to pay a full second tithe, then, of course, a part is acceptable." (Ibid, p. 63).

LET US NOW RETURN WHAT IS DUE TO OUR GOD: SECOND TITHE

"We cannot resort to the denomination's practice of raising goals during church services, for such a practice detracts from the object of the meetings, and desecrates both the house of God and His Holy Day... The Message therefore announces unequivocally that the Davidian who will please the Lord, will faithfully and systematically contribute a second tithe of his increase to this necessary fund.. Let all Present-truth believers faithfully pay a first and second tithe as far as possible, then the Association can maintain its ministerial school, in addition to its boarding school for all needy and worthy children in Present Truth who are of age, and provide a home for the aged, medical care for the needy sick, food for medical care for the needy sick, food for the hungry, and burial for those who fall at their posts of duty." Ibid p. 50-51

We cannot stress more plainly the importance of returning the second tithe. It is left to the individual as we always hear but according to Inspiration it is a command from the LORD to "bring ye all the TITHES into the storehouse" May we do our part brethren and let us leave the results to the Lord. May God bless us all as we strive to do His will this year, 2007

Principles

of Family Finance

"Money May Be a Blessing or a Curse.—Money is not necessarily a curse; it is of high value because if rightly appropriated, it can do good in the salvation of souls, in blessing others who are poorer than ourselves. By an improvident or unwise use, money will become a snare to the user. He who employs money to gratify pride and ambition makes it a curse rather than a blessing. Money is a constant test of the affections. Whoever acquires more than sufficient for his real needs should seek wisdom and grace to know his own heart and to keep his heart diligently, lest he have imaginary wants and become an unfaithful steward, using with prodigality his Lord's entrusted capital. {AH 372.1}

When we love God supremely, temporal things will occupy their right place in our affections. If we humbly and earnestly seek for knowledge and ability in order to make a right use of our Lord's goods, we shall receive wisdom from above. When the heart leans to its

own preferences and inclinations, when the thought is cherished that money can confer happiness without the favor of God, then the money becomes a tyrant, ruling the man; it receives his confidence and esteem and is worshiped as a god. Honor, truth, righteousness, and justice are sacrificed upon its altar. The commands of God's word are set aside, and the world's customs and usages, which King Mammon has ordained, become a controlling power. {AH 372.2}

TIPS ON FAMILY FINANCES

For many families, one of the biggest sources of disagreement and aggravation is the subject of family finances. For many of us, the money coming in never seems to match the money going out. Then of course, there always follows the stress of what to spend the money on, and when, and how much, and where, and on and on.

Getting control of your finances means a lot more than just getting control of


your money. It means getting a handle on your habits – both thinking and spending – as well as your short term and long term goals. Not only can getting control decrease much of your stress (making for a more satisfying family life) it can also help you efficiently prepare for the future (making for a more leisurely life as the family matures). Although many families make use of a

constant uphill battle with the finance gremlins.

Spend Less, Save More

It sounds simplistic, but simple concepts are often the basis for effective life changes. So where do you start to bring your finances under control? Begin by taking the time to work on (and live by)





financial advisor, a large degree of your financial control can be handled on your own.

Leaving your finances "to chance," as so many families do (many without even realizing that they are doing it) is a sure-fire path to allowing them to get out of control. Without a plan – for a budget, for getting the most value out of the things that you buy, and for your future – you will most likely find yourself in a

a family budget – everything else flows from there. Then, concentrate on how to save money on what you own or buy, and how to get the most purchasing power possible. All along the way, try to remember to include planning for the future in your budgeting process whenever you can.

Eliminate the waste: Quit paying large sums of money for things that are rarely used – expensive toys that sit in the cor-

ner, things for hobbies that you never took up, 4-wheel drive SUV's a thousand miles from the nearest snowstorm. Stop "investing" in wasteful items and get rid of those that you have and convert them into cash.

Decrease your debt: Collectively, we keep adding to our debt load month after month. At the same time, our saving rate is generally headed downward. With a super-strong (and growing) economy, you may be able to hold on to such a position for a while, but should the economy stagnate - or crash - you can quickly lose your footing. Start the process by putting the reins on spending that increases your debt load, both on necessary items (like food and shelter) and those that are not necessities (like "toys"). See some tips on saving money on specific items and getting control of your purchases. Then, with the aid of a family budget, begin to designate a specific amount monthly toward reducing the debt - not paying the monthly minimums but adding enough to make a concerted effort at debt reduction. Many families also take advantage of Home Equity Loans, where they can consolidate their debt into a lower monthly payment (and generally a lower interest rate) so that they can concentrate on debt reduction. A good source for comparisons is, where you can get up to 4 offers from lenders, all competing for your business.

Start a program of saving instead of spending: Not only do you have the benefit of eliminating waste (and the availability of money from the elimination) you can begin to focus on long term goals instead of short term spending. If you are not already involved in an investment program (or if you are not devoting enough to it), get started now.

Don't procrastinate: Because of compounding – the negative effect of compounding when it comes to credit (the longer you have the debt the more interest you will pay) and the positive effect of compounding with savings (the longer you have the savings the higher the return) to procrastinate is to cost yourself lots of your hard earned dollars.

It is amazing the difference getting control of your finances will make in your life. Less money will be wasted, so you may find you don't have to work as long (or hard) to make ends meet. That means you'll have more time to spend on the important things in your life. Your stress level most likely decreases in direct proportion to the decrease in bickering over family money.

Financial Planning Begins with Spiritual Values

ning primarily deals with cold hard cash. Most financial planners would disagree. Financial planning is the process of aligning your financial choices with your life passions. And although financial planning can tell you how to accomplish your goals, it cannot tell you what your goals should be. Values transcend the cash and the numbers.

The financial planning process helps families prioritize their core values and structure their finances to better meet their goals. Balancing a family's financial goals and making the financial choices according to those values is at the heart of financial planning. Financial woes often come, not from a lack of income, but from a failure to live according to one's desired values.

Our culture seduces us into believing happiness can be packaged into a commodity that can be wrapped and put under the tree. Consequently, we spend money on fleeting goods and services

that jeopardize the long term goals that that could have provided a deeper fulfillment.

Financial planning begins with life planning. Everyone faces the challenge to purposefully decide what they want to

accomplish with their life and then structure their finances to help them reach those goals. Individuals who have given some contemplation to the spiritual side of life are much closer to being able to provide

an answer to the meaning of their life. Without some spiritual sensitivity it is difficult to even formulate the right questions.

One common temptation is to judge our well-being not by what we have, but by how much we have in comparison to others. Today's borderline poor live as well as the upper-middle class did a few decades ago. But, that does not stop them from feeling poor. Luxuries ultimately disappoint us as we become used to the higher standard of living. But the

luxury loses its luster and the happiness it brings is short-lived.

The old saying is true: Money can't buy happiness. Families earning \$25,000 a year spend money as though they were trying to keep up with those making \$50,000 per year. While those making \$50,000 per year often go into debt trying to live like those making \$100,000. For many families, the lure of "Joneses" wins out over deeper values that require the foresight, discretion and patience of saving.

Financial decisions tug a lot at the conscience. Sometimes the battles of the soul grow into the all out war of a sleep-less night. It is difficult to live life with your head, your heart, your words and your actions all in alignment. When they are not, we live in the pain caused by misalignment. In that regard, comprehensive financial planning touches our soul.

It is difficult to write about family financial values without sounding religious and moralistic, and that's the point.

Ultimately, our financial decisions betray our practical theology. The process of financial planning brings families to decide which values they want to live by, and causes them to adjust their daily monetary decisions to fit those values. To illustrate, imagine a female executive working for a biotech company earning
